The George Veterinary Group is a large, independent practice based in Malmesbury on the edge of the Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Our accredited and recently extended veterinary hospital is home to both of our interns during their first year, ensuring support is all around, and at all times, whilst providing space to make decisions and benefit from a varied caseload.

We are well equipped with a new theatre, diagnostic imaging suites, digital x-ray and laparoscopy - all the toys you would expect to find in a modern hospital.

What you can expect

You will enjoy case responsibility whilst being supported to develop the skills to deal with these effectively and efficiently. Our interns are involved in the managing of day inpatients, carrying out diagnostic procedures, consultations and surgical treatments. You will be supported to develop surgical skills in neutering and other basic procedures with more complex operations as your surgical competence develops.

What we expect

Our two interns are required to be part of the out-of-hours rota, which includes working alternate weekends alongside a more experienced colleague in support as back up. In return, time off is allocated on a rolling rota including a long weekend off after each one worked. Our programme commences mid-August.
